Scholarships for internationals

Hochschule Bremerhaven

The German Federal Ministry of Education and Research and the Federal Foreign office regurarly sponsor scholarships for international PhD students. The scholarships are awarded through different foundations and organizations (see list below). The scholarships are usually awarded bi-anually for 36 months plus I2 month for scholars with children or special needs or pregnant scholars. Scholars receive approx. I350 Euro per month plus money for research and/or additional benefits for children. In addition scholars receive substantial immaterial support through workshops, advanced-training and networking.
